Policy & Procedure Statement

By action of the Board of Trustees, DO tuition and fees for the 2026/2027 academic year (subject to change) are as follows: \$68,000.00.

Admissions Fees & Deposits

Secondary Application Fee\$100

Fee is due and payable upon submission of secondary application for admission via the Applicant Portal. (Fee may be waived for applicants who qualify for AACOMAS Fee Waiver or AAMC Fee Assistance Program.)

Registration Fee\$200

Acceptance Fees & Deposits..... TBA

The Valley College of Osteopathic Medicine has committed to following deposit requirements as set by the American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Application Service (AACOMAS). These deposit guidelines update annually and will be reflected here.

Tuition Payments:

1. A payment of \$1500 is due with the signing of the enrollment agreement.
2. A payment of \$200 is due with the Year One Registration forms.
3. A payment of \$36,500 for Fall Semester Tuition (half the annual tuition) and all books and supplies for the first year are due on or before the first day of classes.
4. A payment of \$34,000 for Spring Semester Tuition (half the annual tuition) is due on or before the first day of Spring Semester classes (Monday, January X, XXXX).

Tuition and fee amounts will be reviewed by The Valley COM Board of Trustees and may be annually adjusted for all students. Updated tuition amounts will be released no later than June 1 each year.
